- Avoid abusive, threatening, or inappropriate language or conduct at all times.
- Support a positive team culture and avoid behavior that causes division or conflict.

#### 3.3 Commitment and Attitude

- Maintain a high level of effort, discipline, and focus during training and competition.
- Arrive on time, be prepared, and participate to the best of your ability.
- Follow all team instructions and respect coaching decisions.

## 3.4 Representation of PAWA

- Understand that you are an ambassador for PAWA and your behavior reflects on the Association.
- Demonstrate sportsmanship, humility, and professionalism in all interactions.

#### 3.5 Health and Wellbeing

- Take responsibility for your physical and mental wellbeing.
- Avoid the use of illegal drugs, performance-enhancing substances, or alcohol during official duties.
- Report injuries, illnesses, or mental health concerns early and honestly.

- Do not engage in bullying, harassment, or discrimination of any kind.
- Encourage and support younger or less experienced teammates.

- Avoid commenting on team selections, tactics, or internal matters in public forums.
- Represent the team and PAWA with dignity online and offline.

# 3.8 Compliance with Rules

- Follow the rules, policies, and codes of conduct set by PAWA, your club, and the sport's governing bodies.
- Be aware of and comply with competition and eligibility requirements.

## 3.9 Accountability

- Take responsibility for your actions and behavior.
- Cooperate with coaches, selectors, and administrators in any reviews or investigations.
- Be open to feedback and willing to improve.

## 4. Breaches of Conduct

Any breach of this Code may result in **disciplinary action**. This may include warnings, suspension, or removal from a team or event, in accordance with **PAWA's disciplinary procedures**.
